



Undergraduate Student Registration Waiver

The Midwestern Criminal Justice Association (MCJA) is pleased to announce a call for applications for its Undergraduate Student Registration Waiver. The waiver provides registration support for a select number of undergraduate students attending the MCJA Annual Meeting.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Current undergraduate student enrolled in at least one (1) credit hour at an accredited institution of higher education during the Fall semester/term of the Annual Meeting
- Must attend MCJA Annual Meeting to be held September
- Must be the lead presenter **or** first author on paper/poster submitted for the Annual Meeting
- Only one (1) student per paper/poster may be eligible to receive a registration waiver

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

Applications must be submitted by the undergraduate student. To apply, please submit:

- Completed application form
- Proof of student status (e.g., copy of enrolled courses, transcripts, or email from a faculty member verifying you are enrolled in at least one [1] credit hour during the conference semester/term; screenshots that include student name, semester, & enrollment status are acceptable)
- Completed applications should be sent to mcja@mcja.org with "Undergraduate Student Registration Waiver" in the subject line
- Incomplete applications or applications that do not meet eligibility criteria will not be considered

DEADLINES

- Application should be submitted no later than **July 15th**
- The Executive Board will notify awardees on or around **August 1st**

AWARDS AND DISTRIBUTION

- Following the review of complete applications across institutions, a limited number of Undergraduate Student Registration Waivers may be granted
- MCJA reserves the right to grant fewer or no waivers based on the applicant pool and available funding
